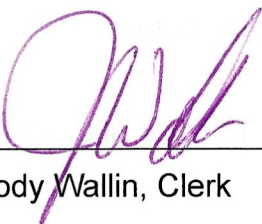
Next Regular Board Meeting – scheduled for Thursday, January 8, 2026 @ 6pm – meeting will include the reorganization meeting, and audit will follow
