

**PELICAN TOWNSHIP
ANNUAL MEETING, PELICAN TOWN HALL
MARCH 10, 2025 7:00 PM**

Clerk called the meeting to order at 7:01 pm.

Pledge of Allegiance was said by all.

Tom Boldt nominated Anita Boldt as moderator, Giles Radtke Seconded. No discussion, vote was called, motion passed unanimously.

Agenda presented, no changes requested, Cindy Terwilliger made motion to approve agenda, Tom Boldt Seconded. No discussion, vote was called, motion passed unanimously.

Police Report – none provided by BPPD

Clerk, Jody Wallin, read minutes of 2025 annual meeting.

Clerk, Jody Wallin, read combined clerks/treasurers financial report – Beginning balance of \$510,328.22, Receipts of \$445,808.86, Disbursements of \$526,346.37, Purchase of Investments (interest on CD's invested back into CD) \$17,651.20, Ending Balance of \$412,139.51 Investment Balance at end of year \$383,838.47 giving total funds of \$795,977.98. Glen Gustafson made motion to approve, John Terwilliger seconded, No discussion, vote was called, motion passed unanimously.

Supervisors Report was given by Giles Radtke, Chairman of the Board.

- For 2025 working in partnership with Crow Wing County, we completed chip sealing on more than a dozen township roads—including Upper Cullen Road, Red Oak Road, Trails End Road, Cree Bay Circle, West Cree Bay Circle, Lindove Lane, Bay Point Drive, Canthook Drive, Lakeview Lane, Pelican Way, Pelican Lake Road, Shelstad Lane, and the Town Hall parking lot. We also executed targeted repairs: installing guardrail signage on Sunset Valley Road, fixing a shoulder washout on Little Pelican Lane with asphalt, hot-patching a developing pothole on Pelican Beach Road, and completing full-depth reclamation paving on Edgewater Circle (with the benefiting property owner covering their share).
- In addition, we are engaged in ongoing discussions with the City of Breezy Point to review and update our road agreement so that Thrane Drive can be brought to standard in the near future.
- Cimino Bay Update – County was not able to get property to enlarge the landing parking lot, shoulder was repaired will check for future
- Seal Coating will be checked at road inspection to determine how it held up to the plow this season and what if any roads we should do going forward.

Micheal McDaid added statements regarding the boards goals of protecting public safety, maintaining infrastructure and planning responsibly. In addition to street sign replacement and culvert safety warnings, the township trimmed the trees on the east side of Ranchette Dr. Of note is the strategic planning of spending a minimum of \$80,000 in road maintenance each of the next 3 years.

Glen Gustafson made a motion to for our posting location to remain Brainerd Daily Dispatch. John Terwilliger Seconded. No discussion, vote was called, motion passed unanimously.

Old Business: Fire protection:

- Nisswa: \$ 7486.00 contract, \$304.00 fireman's relief – total \$7790.00
- Mission: \$20,415.00 contract, \$7932.00 fireman's relief – total \$28,347.00
- Pequot Lakes: \$14,927.87 contract, \$2,042.82 fireman's relief – total \$16,970.69

No new business was brought up.


