

**Pelican Township  
Regular Meeting Minutes  
August 11, 2025 7:00 PM**

**In Attendance:** Supervisors –Giles Radtke (via video), Micheal McDaid, Dave Truchan (joining at 715), Treasurer – Alisha Wallin, Clerk – Jody Wallin, BPPD – Officer Dan Sathre

Radtke called the meeting to order at 7:11 PM. All stood and recited the pledge of allegiance.

**Approval of Agenda** - no additional items were presented, Radtke made motion to accept agenda, McDaid seconded, none opposed - motion carried.

**Police Report Breezy Point** – Officer Sathre provided written report, 20 total incidents, 2 medical, 8 traffic; 2 co-response with the county were domestics.

**Public Comment** – none presented

**Approval of Minutes** – Truchan made a motion to approve the July 8, 2025 Regular meeting, Radtke seconded, none opposed - motion carried.

**Treasurer's Report** – Wallin presented the Treasurer's report as of July 31, 2025. Beginning balance \$568,747.58, receipts \$86,732.89, disbursements \$39,776.42, ending balance \$615,704.05. FNB North CD \$237,577.58 and First Western CD \$140,840.89 McDaid made motion to approve the Treasurer's Report, Truchan seconded motion, Roll Call Vote – Radtke – aye, Truchan – aye, McDaid – aye, none opposed – motion carried.

**Bills were presented for Payment** – Treasurer Wallin presented the bills for payment. The Board reviewed bills and signed checks. Truchan made motion to approve bills as presented, McDaid seconded motion, Roll Call Vote – Radtke – aye, McDaid – aye, Truchan – aye, none opposed – motion carried.

  - McDaid reported that he attended the once a year meeting for heartland cable commission. The money the commission receives from cable companies has not been needed in over 20 years, therefore, they are offering scholarships, we receive a pay out as a participant in the commission. This payment is to be used for one off things – such as computer replacement, printer etc.

Has to get it on their books.

McDaid made a motion to accept quote for replacing with a standard a/c unit for \$7910, Truchan seconded motion, Roll Call Vote – Radtke – aye, Truchan – aye, McDaid – aye, none opposed – motion carried.
