Chair Radtke called the meeting to order at 1:08 PM. All stood and recited the pledge of allegiance.



May 15th, 2025

The continued meeting was called to order at 3:53 PM by Chair Radtke. The meeting was a continuation of a Special Meeting held May 15th 2025 at 1:08 PM that closed at 1:17 PM and continued May 15th, 2025 at 3:53 PM after the road inspection.

In Attendance: Supervisors – Giles Radtke, Michael Mcdaid and Dave Truchan

Road Inspection: The Supervisors discussed their notes and observations from the road inspection. All roads were inspected, and a list of roads below is noted.

Radtke made a motion to approve Michael Mcdaid to spend a not to exceed amount of \$7,500.00 to complete tree trimming on Ranchette and the lining up the sign installation for the guard rails and missing stop sign. David Truchan Second Roll Call Vote was called Mcdaid AYE, Radtke AYE, Truchan AYE motion passed.

Michael Mcdaid made a motion to approve Giles Radtke to spend a not to exceed amount of \$8,000.00 to complete shoulder repairs, crack sealing and polymastic David Truchan Second Roll Call Vote Mcdaid AYE, Radtke AYE, Truchan AYE motion passed.

Dave Truchan will work with Xcel to get Stewarts Bay Drive Patched

Giles Radtke will see if we are responsible for any culvert damage on a driveway on Beaver Dam Drive and will update the board at the next meeting.

Sunset Valley Road – (3) Guard rail cables need signs on each end

Wallins South Shore Drive – Fair, One Driveway needs some class 5 gravel on approach to keep pavement from breaking up

Cullen Channel Lane – Shoulder washed out by bridge, marked with white flags for class 5, 1st section between the landing and intersections needs polymastic and the road from the landing to the dead end needs crack sealing

Little Pelican Drive- Washout on the first driveway to build up with cold mix asphalt

Thrane Drive – Poor

Edgewater Circle – Poor being repaved 2025

Ranchette Drive – Fair, needs tree trimming.

Cimino Bay Drive – Needs gravel shouldering 350'

Stewarts Bay Drive – Xcel energy patching needs to be done

The meeting was adjourned at 4:26 PM.
